

Bookable hard waste

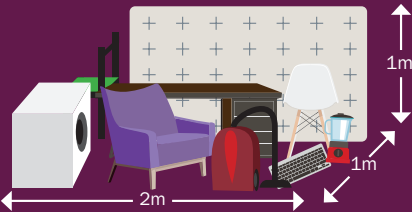
Cardinia households with a kerbside waste service can dispose of up to 4 cubic metres of hard waste per year.

These can be booked as either:

- 2 x collections of 2 cubic metres (2m x 1m x 1m)

OR

- 1 x collection of 4 cubic metres (4m x 1m x 1m)



Accepted items

- ✓ Household appliances and whitegoods
- ✓ Electronic waste (e-waste)
- ✓ Household furniture
- ✓ Mattresses (two per collection)
- ✓ Tied branches and garden waste
- ✓ Timber pieces (max 10 pieces)
- ✓ Car tyres (four per collection)
- ✓ Scrap metal
- ✓ Cardboard

Not accepted

- ✗ Bagged waste
- ✗ Household rubbish, food or recyclables
- ✗ Batteries*
- ✗ Paint or chemicals*
- ✗ Large branches or untied green waste*
- ✗ Barbed wire, fencing wire or panels
- ✗ Building or renovation materials
- ✗ Gas bottles

Electronic waste (E-waste)

E-waste is any broken or unwanted item with a battery, cord or plug.

Take batteries and devices to drop-off points, participating retailers, your local transfer station, or book a hard waste collection.

Rubbish bin (landfill)

Red lid – emptied weekly



Your rubbish bin waste should always be bagged.



- ✓ Household rubbish
- ✓ Soft plastic bags and packaging
- ✓ Damaged clothing, textiles and shoes
- ✓ Single use coffee cups
- ✓ Coffee pods and tea bags
- ✓ Polystyrene and foam
- ✓ Milk and juice cartons
- ✓ Broken glass and ceramics
- ✓ Broken toys (no batteries)
- ✓ Nappies and sanitary items
- ✓ Kitty litter and pet poo



- ✗ Electronic waste (e-waste)
- ✗ Batteries
- ✗ Hazardous chemicals
- ✗ Paint or paint tins
- ✗ Soil or rubble
- ✗ Building materials
- ✗ Household recyclables

Recycling bin

Yellow lid – emptied fortnightly



Your recyclables should always be loose - not bagged.



- ✓ Paper (clean and dry - not shredded)
- ✓ Cardboard (clean, dry and flat)
- ✓ Plastic bottles and containers
- ✓ Glass bottles and jars (lids removed)
- ✓ Steel and aluminium cans, trays and foil



- ✗ Bagged recycling
- ✗ Soft plastic packaging
- ✗ Batteries
- ✗ Electronic waste (e-waste)
- ✗ Clothing, textiles or shoes
- ✗ Polystyrene or foam
- ✗ Single-use coffee cups
- ✗ Nappies or sanitary items
- ✗ Shredded paper

Food and garden waste

Green lid – emptied fortnightly



Contact Council to order your FREE compostable bags (AS4736 bags only)



- ✓ Small branches, twigs and garden clippings
- ✓ Weeds, flowers, leaves and grass
- ✓ Fruit and vegetable scraps
- ✓ Meat, seafood and dairy products
- ✓ Bread, pasta, rice and leftovers
- ✓ Paper towel and shredded paper



- ✗ Plastic bags, packaging or produce stickers
- ✗ Non-organic household waste
- ✗ Bagged garden waste
- ✗ Tea bags or coffee pods
- ✗ Gardening equipment (plant pots or tools)
- ✗ Soil, rubble or rocks
- ✗ Pet poo or kitty litter
- ✗ Treated timber, large branches or stumps

! Batteries and electronic waste should NEVER go in your household bins. Check reverse side for disposal options.
